

Student Evaluation Guidelines for Graduation Research 1

Graduation Research 1 is evaluated in accordance with college-wide rules and policies specified in the course syllabus. Additionally, the ISSE course recommends the following:

1. Students who miss more than 1/3 of the classes in the semester must be failed for the course.
 2. In the beginning of the course, the students should be taught basic knowledge of technical report / graduation thesis writing. Students are expected to work on individual projects, with project themes approved by the instructor. (Students are not necessarily required to select their graduation research theme during the first of the three Graduation Research semesters.)
 3. By Week 15, all students are expected to submit a written report (3000 to 4000 words) via Manaba R+. The report should detail and summarize their research work throughout the semester. All reports are to be checked for plagiarism by the course director (the use of a plagiarism checking system is to be paid from the course budget). Results of the check are to be announced to the instructors within one week after Week 15, and should be taken into account when evaluating the students.
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
